At minimum you should have:

- Earned doctorate in e-learning, instructional design, training and development, or related field
 1. Knowledge of e-learning development based on principles of instructional design, including experience with e-learning development tools such as Articulate Studio, Articulate Storyline, Captivate, and Camtasia

The preferred candidate will have experience in:

- Post-secondary online education, including supervision of student projects
- Designing and developing synchronous, asynchronous, and blended learning interventions in business, military, government, and/or non-profit settings
- Conducting grant-funded research resulting in publications
- M-learning, EPSS, and human performance technology

The IPT department serves a diverse student body with approximately 175 students around the world completing online coursework in any given semester.
